Thank you for your interest in Calvary Baptist Church Academy. Since 1973, CBCA has offered a traditional, academically challenging education for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade. Our mission and purpose is to educate students philosophically, scientifically, historically, and spiritually in the light of God's truth, His Word. We accomplish this goal by employing a godly, dedicated, qualified staff and by using a Christ-centered curriculum.

Our academic program begins in 3-year-old kindergarten and continues through high school. In preschool and kindergarten, we use the A Beka curriculum which emphasizes phonics, number skills and important social skills. Elementary school builds on this strong foundation using A Beka and BJU Press textbooks and other key supplementary resources to develop reading, math, and writing skills while developing an understanding of history, science, art, music, health and Bible. The middle and high school programs are college preparatory in design. Sports, drama, choir, band, art, yearbook design and technology round out the experience.

As a Christian school:

- We believe that God is the source of all truth and that true education stems from this fact.
- We regard time and talents as gifts from God and consequently seek to maintain high standards of achievement.
- We engage consecrated Christian teachers who are personally invested in the spiritual and intellectual development of their students.

A student's past academic achievement will also be considered. Students who have been expelled or have a history of suspensions, however, will not be accepted. Students entering K3 and K4 must be completely potty trained before the first day of school.
